Day-by-Day Itinerary Sept. 28 – Oct. 7, 2017

SEPT. 28: Depart Kansas City for our overnight flight to Ireland.

SEPT. 29: Arrive Dublin, Ireland to be met by Damien O'Reilly, our local driver and guide. We will drive into County Wicklow to St. Kevin's 6th century monastery, Glendalough. Then we will stop for lunch and a chance to shop at Avoca Woolen Mills. Our home for the evening is the spectacular Lyrath Estate in Kilkenny.

SEPT.30: After a full Irish breakfast, we will have a tour of Smithwick's Brewery in Kilkenny. Then our next stop is an included visit of the Irish National Heritage Park, an open air museum which recreates the culture and heritage of Ireland. We then make our way to Wexford for the next two nights. Your city centre hotel is convenient to shopping and pubs.

Scheduled hotel - Talbot Hotel or similar (B)

OCT. 01: Today after breakfast, we will drive to Hook Lighthouse for our included tour. This is the oldest working lighthouse in the world and has existed since the 12th century. Next, we drive to the Kennedy Homestead for our tour this afternoon. We finish the day at the Dunbrody Emigrant ship in Wexford Town. This living museum shows us what the conditions were like on these ships which transported so many Irish family members to America and beyond.

OCT. 02: After our full Irish breakfast, we will travel to Midleton for our included tour of the Jameson Distillery. We then make our way to Cork City where we will enjoy a visit of the historic English Market. Our home for the night is right here in Cork City.

OCT. 03: Enjoy your Irish breakfast prior to our departure for a visit to the Michael Collins Centre in Clonakilty where expert guides will talk of the life and times of this special man. We then go to Blarney where you have the OPTION of kissing the Blarney Stone. Our home for the next three nights is in Killarney, County Kerry.
